facility - the San Francisco Opera House. In 2010, the San Francisco Opera reached an agreement with the City of San Francisco to locate this facility within the historic War Memorial Veterans Building. Featuring

administrative offices, costume production shops, educational and archive facilities and a 300 seat digital performance venue, the Diane B. Wilsey Center for Opera will bring together all of the Opera's artistic and operating functions under one roof. D. R. Young Associates was the lead in the complete implementation of

this effort, directing the design and construction process which opened to the public in 2015.
